

Weather forecast: Hot and Humid!

For those of you who are long term users of hearing aids, you are aware that the summer months wreak havoc on your hearing aids. For the benefit of those new to wearing hearing aids, we have some advice to keep your hearing aids cool, comfortable and functioning during the next few months.

Moisture and heat are two factors that have the greatest affect on the electronics in hearing aids. Now that the weather is hotter, the humidity higher and our activities more outdoors, the aids are more susceptible to funky function. Intermittency, crackling, static, temporary weakness are symptoms of moisture damage. Sometimes swelling of the battery can occur. So what is a person to do?

Never fear, we have solutions for you! First, if the aids get wet, dry them off and open the battery door. LET THEM AIR DRY! Do not use direct heat to dry the aids. If you live in a climate controlled house, as most of us do, this should take care of it. If not, you may need to use a dehumidifier to absorb the rest of the moisture.

If you are prone to profuse sweating then you may want to invest in a heavy duty dehumidifier for daily use, at night. This controls the humidity level in the aids and prevents build up of moisture which will eventually corrode the components.

Some styles are more prone to moisture than others. The aids that fit over the ear are more exposed to sweat and moisture in the air while the custom products are exposed to body temperatures, oil and debris in the canal.
